Subject:- Delegation of powers to sanction medical re-imburement cases under the Employees State Insurance (ESI) Scheme in terms of the J&K Government Business Rules.

In pursuance of Rule 22 of the Jammu and Kashmir Government Business Rules, the Minister for Labour and Employment is pleased to delegate the powers to sanction medical reimbursement claims in favour of the insured persons under the Employees State Insurance (ESI) Scheme to the following officers upto the extent shown against each:-

Designation of the authority to whom delegated	Extent
Insurance Medical Officer (ESI)	Upto an amount of Rs.15,000/-
Administrative Medical officers (ESI)	Upto an amount of Rs.40,000/-
Labour Commissioner, J&K	Upto an amount of Rs.1,50,000/-
Administrative Secretary	Upto an amount of Rs.2,00,000/-

Medical reimbursement cases of the insured persons under ESI Scheme beyond Rs.2.00 lacs shall be submitted to the Minister for Finance, Labour & Employment and Culture for approval.

This is in continuation of the powers delegated, vide Government Order No.69-L&E of 2016 dated: 11-11-2016, read with Government order No.1364-GAD of 2016 dated: 15-12-2016.
