In order to improve efficiency and transparency, each and every organ of government is now switching over to IT based functioning. J&K Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board has launched online portal for registration of workers. This was done with sole purpose to avoid delays, red tapism and also discourage the unscrupulous elements who would pose as "agents".

It has been brought into the notice of administrative department by CEO/Secretary, J&K Building and other Construction Workers Welfare Board that thousands of applications for registration have been received online but no further action is being taken, thereby delaying registration of the workers, which inturn deprives the workers from the benefits to which they are entitled. This has defeated the very purpose of portal based registration.

This has been viewed seriously and any delay in verifying the correctness of claims given in applications shall be dealt with under rules.

All the Assistant Labour Commissioners are impressed upon to ensure that verification is done, through Labour Officer/Labour Inspector using online mode, without any further delay. All pending applications for registrations shall be disposed off within a period of fortnight, positively.
