S.O______ In exercise of the powers conferred by section 35 of the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970 (37 of 1970), the Government of Jammu and Kashmir hereby intends to make following amendments in the Contact Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Jammu and Kashmir Rules, 1972; namely:

- (1) In rule 18, after sub-rule (2), the following sub-rule shall be inserted; namely:
 - "(2a) The Registering officer shall grant the registration within a period of 45 days after receiving the application, if satisfied about the eligibility of the applicant. In case of failure to issue registration within stipulated time, it shall be deemed that the approval has been granted."
- (2) In rule 23, after sub-rule (1), the following rule shall be inserted; namely:
 - "(1a) The licensing officer shall grant the license within a period of 45 days after receiving the application, if satisfied about the eligibility of the applicant. In case of failure to issue license within stipulated time, it shall be deemed that the approval has been granted."

Now, in pursuance of sub-section (1) of section 35 of the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970 (37 of 1970), the aforesaid amendments are hereby published for information of general public for inviting objections, suggestion.

Any person who desires to object the aforesaid amendment may submit his/her objections/suggestion for consideration in writing to the Secretary to

Government, Labour and Employment Department, Civil Secretariat within a period of 15 days from the date of issuance of this notification.

Any objection/suggestion received after the expiry of the said period shall not be entertained.
